

MATERIAL LIST – Mixed: Inside Vintage Book Covers – Orly Avineri

ALL SHOULD FIT IN ONE TOTE BAG (YES, I MEAN IT)

A “SIDEKICK” - A SMALL used (children) book with images/photographs/or illustrations you love, to be altered. (Book should lay flat when worked on and preferably not glossy)

-Four (at least) vintage books that have a cloth cover. They can be found in vintage/antique/ Goodwill, library stores, 2nd hand book stores, and of course online (Etsy, eBay)

-Acrylic Paints (a few colors you love to work with), container for water, paper towels or/and rags

-White Gesso

-Black Gesso

-A couple of different size brushes, from very thin to wide and flat

-Scissors

-Matte or soft/heavy GEL

-White Gel pen (Signo Uniball, Sakura, etc.) and a fine permanent black pens.

-Small flat rusty bits

-Sewing/embroidery needles & sewing and /or embroidery threads in favorite colors

-Lots of small personal images:

Meaningful to you ephemera: Old photographs, miscellaneous papers and materials from personal collections, old journal pages, paintings, letters and personal notes, clippings, bits, and odds, etc. Please make it personal!

Photocopies of small images printed with a laser printer (as opposed to an inkjet).
