

Supplies for Pocket Sketching Workshops with Kath Macaulay

- INSTRUCTOR BRINGS SUPPLIES AND EXTRAS SO YOU DON'T HAVE TO GO FIND THESE! The cost is \$45.00 for paint set, paper, pens, manual, water container, color chart, Swiss knife to open paints.
- Paint Set: Winsor & Newton 14 half pan, Cotman grade watercolor set. (Comes with an acceptable brush)
- Paper: Strathmore 4 x 6 inch Drawing paper. (Not the watercolor paper sold in the same size)
- Pens: Pilot Razor Point. This is the old grey pen with a yellow circle on one end. Micron pen.
- Water container (I bring 35 mm film canisters for everyone)
- Manual
- Extras: If you have a #6 round watercolor brush, bring it. For outdoors on last day you may want a hat, sunblock, folding seat, water bottle (to drink and supply extra water for painting), insect repellent.
- We also bring bags, travel brushes, and videos of the entire workshop, and the new book, *Pocket Sketching, The Portable Workshop* for sale. These are optional extras.

An excellent field seat is made by GCI, will hold 250 pounds, doesn't tip over, has a padded backrest and seat, and no arms (which get in the way). It's the best I've found so far. PO No. 41365. These can be ordered from Sarnoff in Tucson or from Amazon. (price about \$36.00) (We don't bring extras.)
