

Jan Murphy – Many Minis Workshop

If you love to collage or have always been drawn to collage art, this is the workshop for you. Using small (2.5") wood substrate squares, we'll make several mini collages using magazine clippings, text from old books, rhinestones, photos and anything else your imagination comes up with. Once these are completed, we'll arrange them on the substrate of your choosing. Each mini collage is a work of art and when arranged together you'll take home a beautiful piece of meaningful artwork.

Supply List

- Acrylic paints in colors you like (be sure to include black)
- 2 or 3 POSCA paint pens, fine tip (black and white are good for this, but feel free to bring other colors as well.)
- Gloss Mat Medium or Mod Podge
- Clippings from magazines, paper images and ephemera
- Photos or photocopies of photos
- Small trinkets, buttons, bits of jewelry
- Craft glue
- Paint brushes
- Water container for paintbrushes
- Wood substrate. This can be a piece of plywood or repurposed plack, no larger than 12" x 12". I like to use cradled wood panels - **Blick Studio Wood Panels** from DickBlick.com.
