

Shanna Rose – The Magic of Botanical Print (Eco-Print) combined with Natural Dyes Supply List:

- 2 white or light-colored (small pattern ok) 100% Cotton sheets, full, queen or king size, flat or fitted. I source these at our local Goodwill. If you can find a white or light colored/printed flannel sheet please also bring that with you. I will have extra sheets. Please wash the sheets in a mild, unscented detergent before bringing with you. These will be cut up and used as carrier cloths to transfer dye to the silk.
- 1 ball of cotton or hemp string
- 1 pair of paper cutting scissors, 1 pair of scissors to cut cloth (can use paper scissors if new), 1 small sharp pair of scissors for trimming leaves. Grape pruning or bonsai scissors are nice for this.
- small pruning shears to cut stems
- ~The instructor will also have a variety of scissors, shears, and pruners to share
- Silk Scarves and Raw Silk- Order from Dharma Trading

- 3- 11" x 60" silk scarves
- 3- 14' x 72" silk scarves
- You may order any mix of Charmeuse or 16 mm Crepe de Chine scarves
- 2-3 yards of Silk Noil (raw silk)
- optional*- specialty silks like Tussah or Eri Silk from Aurora Silks

- ~You probably won't complete all of these pieces in 3 days, but it's better to have extra to choose from.
- 1 T shirt- cotton, rayon, tencel, lyocell, bamboo, or linen knit will all take the dyes well. It can have a small percentage of spandex.
