

My First Wool Hat – Supply List

MATERIALS:

- **PATTERN**

- [Mega Rib Hat](https://www.ravelry.com/patterns/library/mega-rib) pattern by Kali Sierra Berg on Raverly, \$5:

- **YARN**

- **~90 yards total super bulky** weight wool (*if you want a single color hat, that's one skein of [Malabrigo Rasta](#) - keeping price economical. If you might want a longer hat, aim for more yarn - closer to 100 yards*)
 - *Note: I recommend an additional ~50 yards of contrasting color for a stripe of ribbing at the bottom of the hat, or a stripe in the middle of the hat or two if that's what you desire!*

- **NEEDLES**

- 16" Circular needles US 13
- Double Pointed Needles US 13

- **NOTIONS**

- Darning needle
- Scissors
- Measuring Tape
- Stitch Marker
- Row counter

- **OTHER MATERIALS**

- Toft interchangeable sew on pom pom (you can find them online, but these are two links: [bright colors](#), [pastel colors](#))
- Sewing needle thick enough to go through super bulky wool
- Sturdy thread for sewing on pom pom

For blocking: big bowl, metal can, bowl, towel, fiber wash (recommended: [Soak](#))
