

Oil & Cold Wax Workshop Materials List

Please Bring

- Oil Paints
- Bring 6–10 colors of your choice, including:
 - Titanium White
 - Naphthol Red
 - Cadmium Yellow Medium
 - Ultramarine Blue
- Please do not bring water-soluble oil paints.
- Soft Rubber Brayer
- Available at www.coldwaxacademy.com (navigate to Shop) or Amazon.
- A 4-inch soft brayer is an excellent, versatile size for this workshop.
- Messermeister Bowl Scraper
- Available at www.coldwaxacademy.com or Amazon.
- A 4-inch scraper is recommended for most techniques.
- Palette Knives
- Bring 2–3 palette knives.
- Look for knives that are approximately ½ inch wide with rounded or squared tips. Please avoid knives with sharp, pointed tips.
- Palette
- A piece of plexiglass approximately 12 × 18 inches works beautifully. Disposable paper palettes are also fine.
- Optional: Cradled Wood Panels
- If you would like to work on panels, bring 3–6 cradled panels (¾"–1½" deep).
- We'll begin the workshop on Arches Oil Paper, but you'll have the option of moving to panels as the workshop progresses.
- I'll demonstrate how to prepare panels using polymer medium and gesso, both of which I will provide.
- Texture-Making Tools

Please bring a few objects for creating texture, such as:

- Bubble wrap, Burlap, Corrugated cardboard, Chains, Bamboo skewers;
- Silicone kitchen tools, Mesh, lace, or other textured materials

Feel free to experiment—almost anything with an interesting surface can make a beautiful mark!
